Découverte des sites les plus connus de l'Islande, ceux du fameux Cercle d'Or. Balade dans le Parc National de Thingvellir aux milieux d'une vaste plaine d'effondrement striée de failles que l'on doit à l'écartement des plaques tectoniques. C'est dans ce cadre majestueux, et plus précisément au niveau de la plus large et de la plus belle de toutes ces failles, Almannagjá, que dès le début du X^e siècle, se rassemblèrent chaque été les chefs vikings du pays afin d'établir les lois du pays. Avant de continuer vers le site de Geysir nous nous arrêterons aux serres de Fridheimar pour une introduction de la culture de tomates sous serres, grâce à la géothermie ([voir encadré](#)). Continuation vers la zone géothermale de Geysir où le geyser Strokkur éjecte sa colonne d'eau et de vapeur sur une hauteur de près de 20m toutes les 5 à 8 minutes env. À quelques kilomètres de là, découverte enfin de la spectaculaire chute de Gullfoss où la rivière Hvítá se jette en deux temps dans un beau canyon. Lunch inclus en cours de route.
